


Ring Sizing Guide

There are two easy ways to determine your ring size for the best fit. You can measure an existing ring by comparing it to the size chart below, or measure with our Ross-Simons ring sizer.

Print this page at 100% to ensure size is accurate. See print guidelines below.

MEASURE WITH THE ROSS-SIMONS RING SIZE CHART

Choose a ring that fits the finger on which you plan to wear your new ring, and match the inside of that ring with one of the circles below. When your ring is placed on the correct size, you will only see the white circle inside the ring. If your ideal fit falls between two sizes, we recommend choosing the larger size.


PRINT GUIDELINES

To determine the correct size, print this guide on US Letter size paper (8.5 x 11"), scaled to 100%. Confirm your printout is accurate by placing a credit card within the box below. The scale is correct if the credit card is the same size as the outline shown below.




MEASURE WITH THE ROSS-SIMONS RING SIZER

- 1 Cut out the ring sizer and cut along the horizontal line to create a slit.



- 2 Wrap the ruler around the base of your finger and pull the tapered end through the opening.



- 3 The number that lines up with the edge of the opening is your ring size.*



*To ensure the ring will fit comfortably, we recommend also measuring your knuckle in order to select a size that goes on and off your finger easily.
